

Gunter Gehl Scholarship Guidelines

Revised April 2016

Selection of the \$1000.00 Gunter Gehl Scholarship is awarded based on academic excellence to support the efforts of students and residents who have a connection to the Midwest. The following guidelines will facilitate the process of selecting a recipient:

1. Candidates are eligible if one the following criteria is met:
 - a. NUPOC MPO students who graduated in the year prior to or year of the award.
 - c. Current NCOPE Residents in WI, IL, or IN, or those who completed their Residency in the year prior to the award.
 - d. Current NCOPE Residents (or those who completed their Residency in the year prior to or year of the award) in any state, AND who graduated from high school in WI, IL, or IN.
 - e. Expansion of the eligibility requirements is at the discretion of the Board.
2. Eligible candidates must submit an application and a 1 page summary or abstract of their presentation to the President of the MWC, per the instructions listed on the Chapter website.
3. Notice of the Scholarship will be posted to the Chapter website and promoted via email and social media.
4. Applications will be received by the President. Applications received from eligible candidates will be reviewed by the entire Board.
5. A maximum of four candidates will be selected by the Board to present at either the Fall or Summer meetings, depending on the time available at each meeting.
6. The President will communicate directly with those candidates not selected to present at the meeting.
7. The scholarship winner will be determined by ballots collected at the meeting where the presentations are made.
8. A photo and brief description of the event at which scholarship presentations were made will be promoted on the Chapter website and other P&O publications.
